Regarding 2016 Bahama Christmas Parade

The following rules will apply for the 2016 parade:

1. All floats should have a Christmas related theme. Please no Santa suits.
2. Dirt bikes and four wheelers will not be allowed in the parade.
3. Each entry should provide its own candy.
4. Parade participants should use caution when throwing candy so no one gets hurt. Candy should be thrown towards the ground and not directly at people. The Bahama Ruritan Club is not responsible for injury or damage caused by any parade entry and/or participant.
5. Horse trailers are to be unloaded at the Bahama Ruritan Club and horses ridden to Country Knoll Rd for more information on horses, please contact Ron at (919) 479-1800.
6. Trophies will be given to homemade floats, judged 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
7. All drivers of floats or group coordinators will be required to maintain an appropriate distance between them and the entry in front of them of approximately 15 to 20 feet.
8. Since each float will have a measured space in the lineup on Ball Road please limit vehicles to those in the parade ONLY. Floats can be loaded and vehicles parked at the Little River Community Center before lineup.
9. Please make sure no trash is left in staging area.
10. Please refrain from smoking in line up area and while on parade route.
